

The Annual Report of the Vidyalaya (2017-18)

Good Evening Ladies and Gentlemen!

Distinguished Chief Guest Shri M.T. Krishna Babu , IAS, respected invitees, heads of institutions, parents, teachers and dear students.

It is my privilege today to present the Annual Report of the Vidyalaya for the Academic Session 2017-18 -- a historic session in the life of this institution to be cherished by every one of us.

The Vidyalaya is committed to create an environment, which helps the young minds to blossom and at the same time provide a platform for thinking minds to execute their ideas and dreams for the holistic development of the personality of the students. It is our mission to strive for excellence in every field of work we take up each day.

In retirements, Mrs. Vinita Da Gama Rose retired on superannuation as Vice-Principal on 30th June 2017 and Mr Pajala , SSA, took VRS on 21-07-17.

Almost after two years of the management of the Vidyalaya by the Vice Principals and teachers-in-charge, Mr. Ganesh S. Indrale took charge as the Principal on 15th November 2017.

The other teachers who joined the Vidyalaya are: Mr. Saji R, PGT Physics, Mr Md.Yunus TGT Science and Ms Priti, Ms Neeraj, Ms Parul Yadav Mrs Archana Kumari, Mr Bhagirath, Mr Ravikumar Harsoliya , Mr Pawan kumar and Mr Wadgure Sachin Bhimrao all Primary teachers .

The following teachers also were transferred to their choice destinations- : Mrs Alice Joseph , PGT Physics,.Mr Velayudhan ,TGT Hindi, and Mrs Renu Pandit PRT Music.

May I now present the progress and achievements of our Vidyalaya in brief.

1. Academic Performance:

“The philosophy of the classrooms of one generation will be the philosophy of the government in the next.”

It was a perfect 100% result in classes X and XII in Board Examination 2017-18. At class X level, 126 candidates appeared and the pass % was 100 with 34 securing 90% and above and scholarship of Rs. 5000/- to the first 10 toppers and letters of appreciation from CBSE. The school P.I is 75.26%.

At class XII level, 43 candidates appeared and all of them came out successful. 15 students secured A1 in English, 12 in Chemistry, 8 in Physics, 8 in Maths, 5 out of 20 in Computer Science, 2 out of 31 in Biology and one out of 1 in Hindi.

The *Performance Index* in various subjects: **Hindi : 68.75%, English : 80.52%, Chemistry : 85.47%, Computer Science: 78.98%, Physics : 76.16%, Maths : 72.87%, Biology : 67.26%**

2. Student Achievers of XIIth Class:

Anumegha S. with a percentage of 95.2% (476/500) is the School Topper.

The first three rank holders- Anumegha ,Atul and Anjana won cash award of Ten Thousand Rupees each.

3. Internal Examinations:

In classes I to VIII we have 100% pass and in class IX out of 127 students 98 came out successful with a pass percentage OF 77.17. In class XI out of 49 students 40 came out successful with a pass percentage of 81.63.

Students' Council:

“Strength doesn't come from physical capacity. It comes from unity”

To ensure that our students become active partners in the smooth functioning of the Vidyalaya, the Students' Council is formed. Students learn to be more accountable and

responsible by being more active and creative with their role and assistance towards the overall progress of the school with productive contributions through the Students' Council. A solemn "Investiture Ceremony" was conducted on the 15th of July 2017 to take oath and to collect the badges.

4. Clean School Campaign:

As part of the Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan, Swachhata Pakhwada was observed from 1-09-17 to 15-09-17. Each day's report of various activities with photos had been sent to the regional office daily. This year we conducted a Swachhata rally upto Panambur circle.

The whole school is involved actively in maintaining the campus clean, hygienic and healthy. Cleanliness Drive is taken up almost every month by one of the classes. Awareness is created through talks, posters and essays and skits.

5. Swachhata Monitors:

Each class has Swachhata Monitor forming a Swachhata Sena to take care of the overall cleanliness of the class room and the surroundings.

6. Co-curricular Activities:

To tap the potential in our students, we have a unique way of house system. Co-curricular activities are regularly conducted separately for Primary, Upper Primary and Senior Secondary by way of inter-house competitions. These activities aim at enhancing their talents in different fields.

To develop leadership qualities, each house, in turn, takes up the overall responsibility of organizing the competitions. Class wise morning assembly is another platform for students to showcase their creative potentials.

7. External CCA:

We, in this Vidyalaya, encourage students to take part in external competitions. Many of our students performed well and came out with prizes in Sports, Chess, Karate, Swimming, Dance, Solo Song, Drawing, Art, All India Essay Writing, Online Essay, Online Quiz and Young World Quiz conducted by departments like NMPT, Air Port,

Coast Guard, YMCA, KIOCL, Lions Club, Hindi Prachar Sabha and Book Mark in and around Mangaluru.

Our Students also participated in: CBSE Expression Series on Bal Gangadhar Tilak, CBSE Heritage India Quiz and Wild Wisdom Quiz

8. CMP - Common Minimum Programme for the Primary Classes:

The first Cluster Level CMP was conducted at K.V No.2 Mangaluru 22-07- 17

The second CMP was at K. V. Karwar on 28-10-17. The third CMP was held at KV No.1 Mangaluru on 16-12-17 and the fourth at KV Udupi on 07-03-18.

9. Celebrations:

This year in addition to the National Day Celebrations and regional festivals we had National Unity Day, Constitution Day, National Education Day, Swach Bharath Abhiyan, Vigilance Awareness Week, Children's Day, Hindi Pakhwada, Sanskrit Week, Language Week, Swatchhata Pakhwada, Environmental Awareness Day, Communal Harmony Week, , All Faith Prayer, Martyr's Day, Science Day and KVS Foundation Day celebrated in a befitting manner with great enthusiasm and fervor. 20th November was observed as International Children's day.

10.Sports and Games:

16. Guidance and Counselling:

The overall academic ambience of the School is now more peaceful and totally stress free. The teachers who have attended short term workshop on guidance & Counseling are also contributing their best especially in providing Guidance on career choices for the 11th and 12th Graders together with the Counselor.

A workshop on Cyber Crime by Dr. Ananth Prabhu G and another session on Drug Abuse by Shri. Shankar Naik was held at the JNC Hall at 8 A.M. on 24-06-18 where participation of the parents was house full.

17. AEP-(Adolescent Education Programme):

Special and combined classes and discussions are frequently held on topics like peer influence, peer pressure, gender equality, substance abuse and prevention of HIV and AIDS and the trap of unethical internet and video games.

18.Yoga:
